

***** State of Illinois Grade Requirements *****

To test for a license, the State of Illinois requires a student to have a Certificate of Completion (“blue slip”) for which the student must first provide proof of grades to Top Driver.

- Grades must be for the 2 most recent semesters or 4 quarters if the student’s school is on a quarter system
 - Grades can be from a high school or a middle school depending on which school(s) the student attended in the two most recent semesters
 - Student must have passed at least 8 courses; if not, the student can submit a waiver form signed by a school official (ask Top Driver instructor for form)
- Acceptable forms of grade documentation:
 - Grade Verification Form signed by the school (does not require grades)
 - Copies of report cards
 - Transcripts

To avoid delays in applying for the student’s blue slip and the student testing for their license, Top Driver requires proof of grades be submitted on or before *the first class*.
