



Student Grade Verification

The Illinois Secretary of State requires that all students enrolled in a Driver Education Program show proof that they are in good standing with their high school. A completed **Grade Verification Form** is required by Top Driver before a Certificate of Completion can be processed.

- The **Grade Verification Form** must be signed by:
 - The Student
 - A Parent
 - A High School Administrator
- Home schooled students can provide the *Home School Parental Consent Form* (provided on www.topdriver.com under “Key Documents”)

To avoid delays in processing the Certificate of Completion (required before a student takes their driver’s license test), students should submit the Grade Verification Form *on or before the first day of class.*
