Vehicle Maintenance Checklist

Once a Month:



Washer Fluid Level Under the hood of your vehicle is a plastic container that contains the fluid for your windshield wipers. If it isn't full of liquid, you can fill it with a windshield washer solution.

Tire Pressure/Wear Check tire condition and pressure. Do they look low or are there any visible cracks? You need tires that are in good condition so that you can brake and steer properly.

Once Every 3 Months:

Automatic Transmission Fluid If your vehicle hesitates when your automatic transmission shifts gears, get the transmission fluid level checked. Replacing your transmission fluid helps preserve the life of the transmission and maintains the warranty.

Brake Fluid Keep the brake fluid in the master cylinder at the proper level. It's important to be proactive, but if you think your vehicle leaking brake fluid, don't drive it, tow it!

Every Six Months:

Windshield Wiper Blades If your wipers have been making a mess of your windshield, it's time to replace your windshield wiper blades.

Power Steering Eliminate the moaning and groaning caused by your faulty power steering system by checking and getting your power steering fuel changed. If there isn't enough fluid, steering becomes more difficult and either the pump or rack and pinion could be damaged without fluid to cushion them.
